TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PAYMENTS: e-Transfer (preferred), Cheque, Credit Card Send e-transfers to skatesarniatreasurer@gmail.com

At least 50% is to be paid upon registration with the balance paid by Nov.15. All fees must be paid in full prior to tests, competitions and carnival.

A Family Discount is available for a family with 3 or more skaters. Discount determined at registration.

\$30 service fee charged on NSF cheques. Anyone with 2 NSF cheques must pay by e-Transfer or cash only.

All past due accounts must be paid prior to new season registration. Partial fee payment is not an option for skaters with an overdue account.

REFUND POLICY:

Refunds will only be given during first 3 weeks of your skating session. A \$90 fee will be withheld. Refund requests must be submitted in writing to the Club Treasurer skatesarniatreasurer@gmail.com

SKATE CANADA PRIVACY POLICY

Skate Canada requires clubs to include the Notice of Collection Statement on their registration forms. Skate Sarnia uses the personal information collected on the registration form in order to:

- Contact skater/parent re: Club activities or events
- Arrange for appropriate costumes for the carnival
- Register the skater with Skate Canada

Personal information collected on the form includes:

- Skater Name, sex, birth date
- Parent/Guardian Name, address, phone number, email address

The Skate Canada Privacy Policy is intended to ensure your personal information is used only for its intended purpose, accessible only on a need-to-know basis, and not disclosed without authorization nor used for personal gain. All Skate Sarnia Board Members and Professional Coaches are required to sign and abide by the Skate Canada Privacy Policy as a condition of being on the Board or employed as a coach. CANSKATE PROGRAMS

CanSkate is a learn-to-skate program focused on fun, participation & basic skill development needed to take part in any skating sport. It's offered in 3 ability-based programs. Skaters may progress to the next level during the season through regular on-session testing. Awards & incentives help encourage skaters. Professional Coaches aided by trained Program Assistants teach the programs.

PRECANSKATE

Typically geared to pre-school children with little or no skating experience, this program is focussed on fun & participation in age appropriate activities.

One session/week: Sunday at 10:15 or 3:30

CANSKATE

Geared towards skaters with previous skating experience must be able to fall down, get up and skate forward with little assistance. Skaters are grouped according to ability to develop basic skating skills for CanSkate Stages 1 to 3.

One session/week: either day, Sun/Thurs \$475

\$685 Two sessions/week: both days

ADVANCED CANSKATE

For experienced skaters above CanSkate Stage 3 who will progress to Stage 6 as they develop higher skating skills.

\$475 One session/week: either day, Sun/Tues

\$685 Two sessions/week: both days

STAR GROUP

This is a bridge between Advanced CanSkate & StarSkate/ Competitive, introducing skaters to ice dance, skills & free skate in a group format. Skaters require CanSkate Stage 6.

One session/week: either day, Sun/Tues \$685 Two sessions/week: both days

STARSKATE/COMPETITIVE SESSIONS

Skaters continue building their skating skills in ice dance. skills, singles (freeskate) & interpretive skating. Professional Coaches offer instruction in semi-private &/or private lessons. Skaters require CanSkate Stage 6 & a Coach.

STAR Private Lesson Sessions

Level "A" sessions: geared for STAR 4 and up Level "B" sessions: geared for up to STAR 4

Registration fees are based on number of STAR sessions selected. Lesson fees are extra, paid directly to your coach.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Our Board of Directors are all volunteers who have had many years of experience with Skate Sarnia, as skaters or parents of skaters and as volunteers. We strive to do our best in providing programs & coaching staff that meet the needs of our skaters. Our email address for the Board is:

POWER SKATING

Power Skating is designed to help hockey skaters develop better balance, power, agility, speed & endurance. Skating skills, techniques & conditioning drills are taught in a way that emphasizes how the skills apply to game situations. Hockey gear is required. The program is offered on two sessions, both on Wednesday.

\$ 565 One session/week: Wednesday 5 or 6 PM

\$ 455 One session/week: Friday 4 PM (see note below)

ADULT SKATERS

Experienced adult skaters may register for the StarSkate/ Competitive sessions. A professional coach is not a requirement but is an option if they wish.

GUEST SKATING

StarSkate/Competitive skaters who wish to have extra ice from time to time may request to "Guest Skate". The request is made through their coach to the Board. If granted, the "Guest Skate" is valid in one-hour increments and ONLY for the approved time. Fee is \$30/hr.

CARNIVAL PRACTICE

The last two weeks of scheduled skating sessions are exclusively reserved for carnival practice. Only skaters who registered for carnival are permitted on the ice.

SKATE CANADA HELMET POLICY

All skaters, including adults, at CanSkate Stage 5 or below must wear a CSA approved hockey helmet while on the ice. In general, this applies to anyone who lacks good control/balance when skating forward or backward, or difficulty stopping & manoeuvring around ice obstacles.

PROMOTIONAL BOOKLET

This fundraiser supports our club & Skate Ontario. The cost is included in the registration fee. You sell the 20 \$2 tickets to family & friends & keep the \$40. Ticket stubs must be returned by January 31st. If you don't sell all the tickets, enter your own name on any unsold tickets before returning the stubs.

PROFESSIONAL COACH FEES

Professional Coaches are available for private lessons on StarSkate/Competitive sessions. Professional Coaching fees are NOT included in the club registration fees. All Professional Coach fees are paid directly to the Coach.
